

The regular monthly meeting of the Fox Township Board of Supervisors was held August 5, 2020 at 6:00 PM. Those present: Matt Pontzer, Dave Mattiuz and Randy Gradizzi, supervisors, Kathy Dowie, secretary-treasurer, Rob Singer, Judy Woelfel, Katelynn Decker, Mark Decker, Mitchell Newara, Tracy Decker and Amy Cherry, newspaper reporter.

Chairman Dave Mattiuz called the meeting to order and began by acknowledging the recipients of the Fox Township/ Advanced Disposal Greentree Landfill scholarships: Mitchell Newara, Matthew Krull, Katelynn Decker, Jenna Minard and Nathan Schneider. Checks were presented to the recipients that were in attendance. There were no visitor comments.

A motion was made by Randy Gradizzi, seconded by Matt Pontzer to approve the minutes from the meeting of July 1, 2020. Motion carried.

### **UNFINISHED BUSINESS**

There was no unfinished business to discuss.

### **NEW BUSINESS**

An updated agreement for the Elk County Recycling Drop-Off Program was received and reviewed. A motion was made by Randy Gradizzi, seconded by Matt Pontzer to accept this agreement. Motion carried.

Chairman Mattiuz reminded residents to complete their 2020 Census Survey by September 30<sup>th</sup>. In-person visits at households that have not yet responded to the census have begun in Pennsylvania but you can still complete the on-line survey. It takes only a few minutes, but it affects the allocation of funding for our community's public resources such as roads, schools, and hospitals as well as how we plan for the future and our voice in government.

The following bills have been submitted for approval for payment:

- From the General Fund, check #28196 thru check #28247 in the amount of \$63,300.85
- From the Landfill Fund, check #1986 thru check #1996 in the amount of \$249,093.59
- From the Fire Protection Fund, check #1647 and check #1648 in the amount of 1,676.01
- From the Toby Water account, check #1263 thru check #1272 in the amount of \$13,154.20
- For a TOTAL of \$327,224.65

A motion was made by Matt Pontzer, seconded by Dave Mattiuz to approve the bills as presented. Motion carried with Pontzer and Mattiuz in favor. Randy Gradizzi was in favor of the motion but abstained from check #28237 and #1270 to St. Marys Water, as he sits on the Board.

### **OTHER BUSINESS**

Randy Gradizzi reported that the new plow truck was delivered and that the Sheeley Road project has been completed.

With no further business to discuss, a motion was made by Matt Pontzer, seconded by Randy Gradizzi, to adjourn this meeting at 6:06 PM. Motion carried.
