The Fox Township Planning Commission has reviewed the following subdivision and recommended it for approval:

Russ Braun is subdividing a 0.259-acre parcel from his property located along West Theresa Road to be added to his other parcel containing his existing home. A Form B waiver has been submitted. A letter was received from PennDOT that they will be placing electronic counters in various Townships that will be collecting safety data. These devices are not speed traps.

A motion was made by Dave Mattiuz, seconded by Randy Gradizzi to send a response to the resident's letter asking why the Township discontinued the collection of glass for recycling. Motion carried.
