

The regular monthly meeting of the Fox Township Board of Supervisors was held June 5, 2019 at 6:00 PM. Those present: Mike Keller, Dave Mattiuz and Randy Gradizzi, supervisors, Kathy Dowie, secretary-treasurer, Amy Cherry, newspaper reporter, Jim Nissel, Rick Krishart, Carole Harshbarger, Mark Saline, Patty Friedl, Bernie Greenawalt, Chelsea Strathen, Rob Woelfel, Mike Kamendulis, Cody Woelfel, Terry Krishart and Justin Krishart

Chairman Keller called the meeting to order and began by acknowledging the visitors.

Bernie Greenawalt stated that a ditch which runs between Laurel and Fern Lanes, near his property needs cleaned. In the recent heavy rain storms, waters backs up onto his property. Randy Gradizzi responded that there is no Township-owned right-of-way for the ditch in question. Historically, the Township does not clean privately owned ditches. They Board did agree to look at the situation before making a final decision.

There were no other visitor comments.

CORRESPONDENCE

The Social Ministry Committee of Fox Township requested a traffic light with pedestrian control be placed at the crosswalk located on Rt. 948 near St. Boniface. Randy Gradizzi obtained a price quote for a solar powered unit, with a cost of \$9,866. He is working on getting other quotes. A motion was made by Randy Gradizzi, seconded by Dave Mattiuz to submit a request to PennDOT for these units to be placed near the crosswalk on Rt. 948. Motion carried. The Board will need to see if they have PennDOT's permission before proceeding with the project.

Landfill inspection report dated 5/22 was received and is available for review.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Randy Gradizzi reported that the paving was done at the park. The company will be painting the lines soon.

NEW BUSINESS

The Fox Twp. Planning Commission has reviewed the following subdivision and recommended it for approval:

Joseph Resch Jr and Margaret Resch are subdividing a 1-acre parcel from their property located along Laurel Estates Lane. This lot will be conveyed to Cory Nesbitt to be used as a lot-extension to the parcel containing his existing home. A Form B Waiver has been submitted.

A motion was made by Randy Gradizzi, seconded by Dave Mattiuz to approve this subdivision as presented. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Randy Gradizzi, seconded by Dave Mattiuz to advertise for sealed bids for the replacement of the municipal building roof on the garage side. Motion carried.
