

The regular monthly meeting of the Fox Township Board of Supervisors was held May 5, 2021 at 6:00 PM. Those present: Matt Pontzer, Dave Mattiuz and Randy Gradizzi, supervisors, Kathy Dowie, secretary-treasurer, Amy Cherry, newspaper reporter, Robin Singer, Jim Nissel, Mike Kamandulis, Dan Mosier and Jack Mosier, Troop 94.

Chairman Mattiuz called the meeting to order and began by acknowledging the visitors, however, there were no visitor comments.

A motion was made by Matt Pontzer, seconded by Randy Gradizzi to approve the minutes from the meeting of April 7, 2021. Motion carried.

CORRESPONDENCE

Notice was received that DEP approved the application to change ownership from Advanced Disposal Services Greentree Landfill, LLC to the Greentree Landfill, LLC.

A letter was received requesting a streetlight to be placed at the intersection of Dagus Mines Road and Hemlock Lane. The Board will look at the site and address this at the next meeting.

A letter was received requesting that "Woodley Run" be cleaned the allowable 50 feet on each side of Main Street. The resident contacted PennDOT, but did not receive a response. Randy Gradizzi stated that he called PennDOT and that they plan on cleaning this at the end of June.

An email was received concerning the intersection of Dagus Mines Road/Skyline Drive and Toby Road. With another recent accident at this intersection, the resident asked if something could be done to improve the safety at that location. PennDOT has been notified of the request and will be conducting a study of the intersection to what could be done.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

The lease to between the Elk County Riders and Fox Township to construct a Trail Head on Township property along Boone Mt Road was accepted and will executed by both parties.

NEW BUSINESS

There was no new business to discuss.

The following bills were submitted for approval for payment:

- From the General Fund, check #28507 thru check #28544 in the amount of \$23,830.82
- From the Landfill Fund, check #2026 thru check #2029 in the amount of \$9,455.94
- From the Fire Protection Fund, check #1656 in the amount of \$126.46
- From the Toby Water account, check #1317 thru check #1320 in the amount of \$6,527.28
- For a TOTAL of \$39,940.50

A motion was made by Matt Pontzer, seconded by Dave Mattiuz to approve the bills as presented. Motion carried with Pontzer and Mattiuz in favor. Randy Gradizzi was in favor of the motion but abstained from check #28509 and checks # 1319 to St. Marys Water, as he sits on the Board.

OTHER BUSINESS

The deadline to purchase a Hometown Hero Banner is May 28th. Information can be found on our website foxtownship.com or stop at the Municipal Building. The first round of banners will be displayed in the Township by the end of June. 74 banners have been sold to-date.

Randy Gradizzi announced that the Dirt and Gravel Road project for Gardner Hill Road was approved for funding and will be done this fall.
