

The regular monthly meeting of the Fox Township Board of Supervisors was held October 7, 2020 at 6:00 PM. Those present: Matt Pontzer, Dave Mattiuz and Randy Gradizzi, supervisors, Kathy Dowie, secretary-treasurer, Rob Singer, Amy Cherry, newspaper reporter and Lauren Zickepoose from Northern PA Regional College.

Chairman Dave Mattiuz called the meeting to order and began by acknowledging the visitors. Lauren Zickepoose presented an overview of the programs offered by the Northern PA Regional College. There were no other visitor comments.

A motion was made by Matt Pontzer, seconded by Randy Gradizzi to approve the minutes from the meeting of September 2, 2020. Motion carried.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

NEW BUSINESS

A motion was made by Randy Gradizzi, seconded by Matt Pontzer to accept the Minimum Municipal Obligation for the 2021 budget in the amount of \$1,600. Motion carried.

Currently, the Township is paying to have the glass and aluminum recycling container pulled by Advanced Disposal. Randy Gradizzi suggested that since this container is now full, that it be pulled for the last time and not returned. Metals could then be placed in the scrap container and glass no longer accepted as a recyclable. Residents wishing to recycle their glass could take it directly to the Elk County Recycling Center. A motion was made by Dave Mattiuz, seconded by Randy Gradizzi to discontinue the use of the glass and aluminum recycling container, as proposed. Motion carried.

The following Use of Facility requests were submitted for approval:

A motion was made by Randy Gradizzi, seconded by Dave Mattiuz to approve these requests. Motion carried.

The 2021 Budget Schedule will be as follows: a workshop will be held on October 20th at 4 PM with additional workshops being scheduled as needed. The Proposed Budget was scheduled to be adopted at the November 4th meeting and the Final Budget at the December 2nd meeting.

The Board set the hours for Trick-or-Treating on October 31st, 6-8 PM.

A motion was made by Matt Pontzer, seconded by Dave Mattiuz to approve the bills as presented. Motion carried with Pontzer and Mattiuz in favor. Randy Gradizzi was in favor of the motion but abstained from check #28319 and #1284 to St. Marys Water, as he sits on the Board.
